Entry on Race Day discouraged, but allowed

Held under USAC Rules and Permit 2016-2858

Date: Saturday September 17, 2016.

Location: Esparto High School, Downtown Esparto, CA.

Directions: From Hwy 505 between Vacaville and Dunnigan, take Hwy 16 exit west to Esparto. Turn right onto Yolo Street and then right onto Plainfield St and park. Registration will be as indicated on signs. Start is 6 blocks north on Yolo Street, at Road 87 and Road 20X.

Memorial: This race is dedicated to Allen Brumm, the rider who in 2015's event, has run over and killed by a driver on the course. This year's race has no out-and-back section to help reduce this kind of tragedy.

Registration: It is strongly suggested to pre-enter this race, for everyone's sanity. Check-In and race day entry opens at 6:30 a.m. and closes at 7:45 a.m. for all 60-second starts. First rider starts at 8:01 a.m. and riders go in the category order listed below.

Course: An 18-mile total loop open road tt course. Course is Road 87 north to Road 14, then east to Road 90A and turn right (south) to Road 19, then right (west) on Road 19 to finish just **before** the intersection of Road 87. Mostly flat, with a few small rolling hills (a la Snelling). Part of the course is the south end of the Dunnigan Hills road course. This is different than previous years, NOT an out-and-back course

Starts: Cat 1/2/Pro will start first, at 8 a.m. in rider number, followed by the groups as listed above. Numbers for most riders will be pre assigned and handed out at race registration, we hope to have a listing.

Prizes: tee shirts to top 3, 25% of entry fees (cash) for each category split to top 3. No cash prizes for Cat 5

How to Enter:

Enter OnLine at www.bikereg.com from August 16 to September 11, 2016 for above fees plus on-line surcharge. From September 12-14, the fee on-line is \$7 additional. **No online entry after Aug 14 11:59 pm PST.** You'll need to sign and date your entry form/release at race registration desk.

---By Mail: You may still enter by mail. By mail, send standard USAC entry form/release along with fee above (if Postmarked by Friday Sept 18 and received by Sept 9) to Velo Promo/Allen Brumm-Esparto, 19780 Soulsbyville Road, Soulsbyville, CA 95372. For. **Note: indicate what category you are entering on check or form. Entries for several races in one envelope ok, but be sure to list race names on the outside. Envelopes without names of races on the outside may go to the wrong race.**

---At Race: You can enter race day (we discourage it), but get there early, for \$40.

2016 USAC license required (available at race). One day licenses are available only for Cat 5 or Women 4 . Entry fees include \$1 NCNCA and \$3.75 USAC insurance surcharges. Numbers will be provided.

Credits: Credit for another VP race will be given if VP is notified at tech@bikereg.com by 5pm PST Wednesday 9/14 that you can't compete. No credit issued if you plan to enter another race instead; no cash refunds. No substitutions for cancellations. **Send e-mail for credit to: tech@bikereg.com**

Champion Discounts: Champions pay normal fees up front; Current NorCal/Nevada District Time Trial Champions and National Time Trial Champions will get a refund at the reg desk of all but \$3 per day if 1) their entry is received by the deadline above (otherwise they pay full fee, including late fee) and 2) they ride in the category they won the championship in (Master Champions may ride down in age, and ride for \$3, and Juniors may ride up. District jersey is not required.

Rules: Riders while competing must remain in the right half of the right lane on the course except while passing; after finishing and returning to Esparto, riders must ride single file. *There is other traffic on the roadway; always be aware of it and be prepared to slow and/or maneuver; and warn riders behind you of hazards.*
